Re: 2012 Permanent Numbers Guidelines

The application form for 2012 SEDiv Permanent numbers is posted on www.SEDivRacing.org . It will not be mailed. ALL SEDIV LICENSED DRIVERS MAY APPLY FOR A NUMBER. NUMBER RENEWALS, SAVE YOURSELF SOME PROBLEMS – **FILL THIS OUT NOW!!!!** DON'T LOOSE YOUR PERMANENT NUMBER. THE DEADLINE TO APPPLY and keep your permanent number is **2-20-2012**. All applications must be received by 2-20-12 **There will be no grace period.** If you have not renewed by 2-20-12, you may lose your number to a new applicant.

Please note that there is a **\$20 fee** for applying for a permanent number. All applications must be mailed and \$20 cash, check or money order made payable to SEDIV SCCA must accompany the application. Cash may be sent but is at your own risk. No faxes or telephone applications will be taken. The \$20 fee will be used for administrative fees associated with permanent numbers. Any excess will be used by the SEDIV for other administrative programs as directed by the SEDIV RES.

Please note that the same number is assigned to more than one driver based on the tracks at which that driver may compete and whether a driver competes on the national level or regional level. In simple words, if a driver enters only Regionals in the south end of the division, then that permanent number will be only for the tracks in the south end of the division and only at regional races. Someone else may have the same number assigned for National races and another driver that same number for Regionals in the north end of the division. This will make the numbers go much further in several of the groups that have far more cars than numbers available for assignment. Due to the volume of cars in Group 5, only National drivers who competed at both north & south tracks in 2011 will receive a number assignment for both north & south tracks . South end of the Division is all Florida tracks. All the other SEDiv tracks are considered north tracks for permanent number assignments.. A car which is run in more than one class must be paid per class. Thus, two classes=two fees.

Renewal number assignments will be posted on the SEDiv website, www.sedivracings.org 2-1-12.

Numbers will be assigned on the following priority basis when duplicate number requests are received at the same time.

1. Renewals having competed at more than 3 races in 2011.
2. National competitors having attended the Runoffs
3. SARRC competitors attending the SIC
4. National competitors not attending Runoffs.
5. ECR competitors.
6. SARRC competitors not attending the SIC.
7. All other competitors on a first received basis.- Picking an unassigned 2011 number will insure getting your number!

New applicants please note. You must fill in all seven of the choices for a number. If none of these are available, I will contact you with numbers that are available at the time you apply. I can hold new applications until the 2-20-12 deadline to see if one of your choices becomes available but the chances of receiving a number become less the longer you wait. You can check for unassigned numbers for 2011 at www.sedivracings.org

Note: Numbers not assigned in 2011 will be assigned on a first received basis. **Save yourself time & trouble. All on line registration systems will soon give preference to permanent numbers. Apply now.**

Numbers assigned for 2012 do not take effect until 3-15-12.
