

# SEDIV TIME TRIALS RULES

as of: 4 Jan 11

1. These South East Division (SEDIV) Time Trials (TT) rules apply to all SEDIV Level 2, Level 3, and Level 4 Time Trials events. SEDIV TT designated points events shall constitute the basis for the SEDIV TT Championship Series. These SEDIV TT rules supplement the Sports Car Club of America (SCCA) Time Trials Rules (TTR).
2. Competition is open to all SCCA licensed drivers. SEDIV Time Trials participants must have either a Time Trials Driver, Time Trials Novice, FIA or Road Racing license as allowed in the TTR. Please consult the TTR and General Competition Rules (GCR) for acceptable alternate competition licenses. Some Time Trials Events (i.e., Level 4) may require all drivers to have "full" (non-novice) TT licenses.
3. SEDIV TT Championship awards will be presented in accordance with these SEDIV Time Trials Rules. Awards will be presented at the annual SEDIV meeting.
4. To qualify for a class championship, a driver must compete in 50% of the SEDIV TT designated points events on the calendar as distributed after the SEDIV Annual Meeting. In the event of an odd number of events, round up to the next whole number. If there are 8 events, 4 are required for a trophy; if there are 9 events, 5 are required for a trophy. In the event of a tie, the tie breaker will be head-to-head competition or the most first place finishes, in that order.
5. Drivers may earn points in all events sanctioned by the SEDIV Time Trials Committee as SEDIV TT designated points events. Points earned in the number of SEDIV TT designated points events, minus two, will be counted for year end championships (i.e., if there are 8 events, the top 6 will count for championship points).
6. TT Championship points will be awarded by finishing points position (in each class) as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> - 9, 2<sup>nd</sup> - 6, 3<sup>rd</sup> - 4, 4<sup>th</sup> - 3, 5<sup>th</sup> - 2, 6<sup>th</sup> - 1, 7<sup>th</sup> - 1, 8<sup>th</sup> - 1, 9<sup>th</sup> and lower -1, DNF-1, DNS-0.
7. Drivers may waive championship points for any particular event (please indicate that you plan to waive points at the event's registration). No championship points may be waived after close of event registration. Only TT championship points are waived. Finishing position for trophies for the event will be awarded based on actual time without regard for waived points. TT championship points will be awarded to the drivers in order of their finishing points position (i.e., if a driver waives championship points, each driver finishing below him moves up in the points award order).
8. Points will be awarded (and course records recognized) in the following GCR, Regional, TT, and SOLO classes (reference the SEDIV TT Class Rules):

GCR Classes:           FA, FB, FC, FE, FF, FS, FST, FV, FM, CF, F500, ASR, CSR, DSR, S2000, SRF, LC, STO, STU, GT1, GT2, GT3, GTL, AS, EP, FP, HP, T1, T2, T3, ST, SSB, SSC, ITA, ITB, ITC, ITR, ITS, Spec Miata

Regional/TT Classes: SPECIAL (SP), V-O, V-C, SPO, SPU, GTA, IT7, ITO, SU, F600

SOLO Classes: Street Mod (SM), ASP, BSP, CSP, DSP, ESP, FSP, SSM

Classes not listed above may be offered by the hosting Region in the Supplemental Regulations (SUPPS), but they will not be eligible for SEDIV TT points.

9. Cars must have a TT or Competition Log Book and meet the technical and safety requirements of the GCR and/or TT rules. Annual TT or Road Race Technical inspections are sufficient although cars may be fully inspected at the discretion of the event Tech Inspector. In the case of an Annual Tech inspection, the driver shall present his/her logbook for inspection at the event. Annual TT Tech inspections shall be valid for 12 months from the date of the inspection.
10. Multi-driver cars will be allowed as long as the car is properly numbered for each driver. Event organizers have the right to limit the number of drivers per car.
11. The TT trophy fund for each TT points event will be \$5.00 for each paid entry (refunded entries are not paid entries). The event Region will submit the payment (payable to "TT SEDIV") to the TT Committee Points Keeper within thirty (30) days of the event. Failure to comply may result in a fine not to exceed \$300.00. Before any fine may be imposed, the TT Committee must meet to discuss the infraction and amount of fine. The decision must pass by a two-thirds vote.
12. Official results of the event shall be submitted to the TT Committee Points Keeper within seven (7) days of the event. Results shall include driver name, driver SCCA member number, Region, car class, car number, car type, place in class, waiver of points (if applicable), and finishing time.
